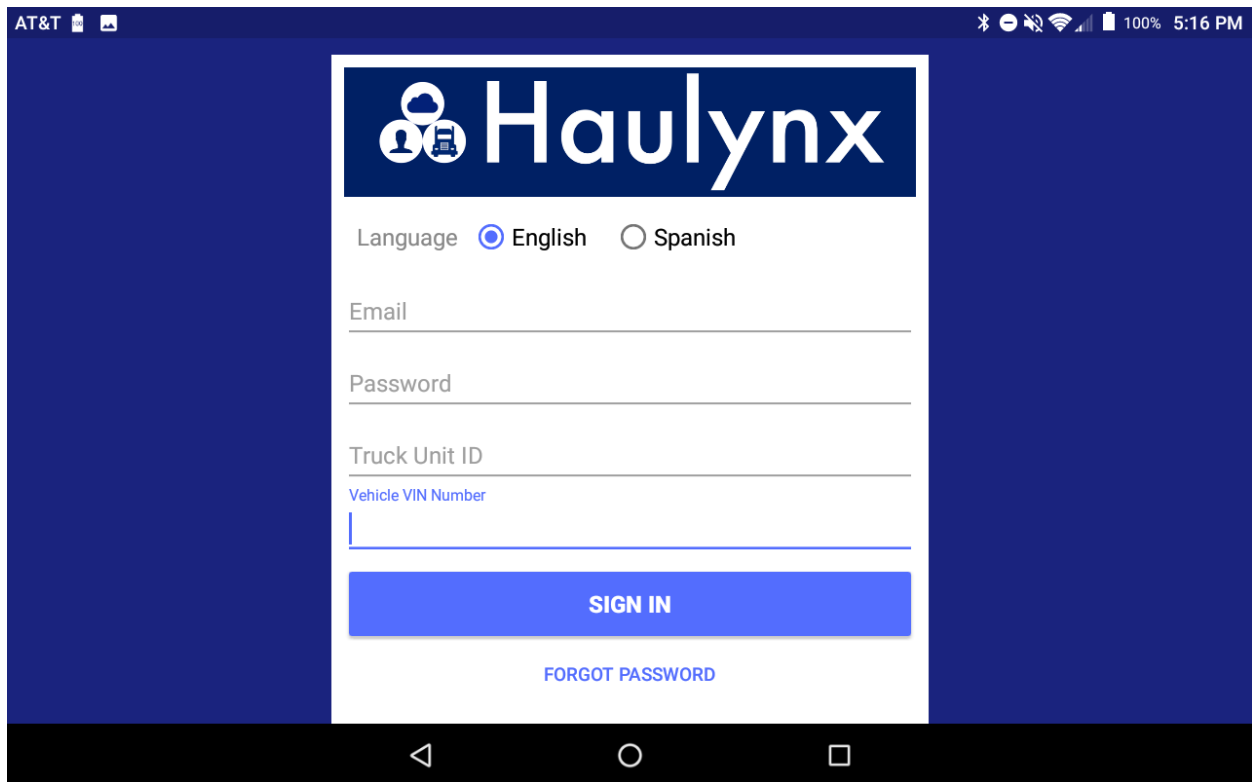

SIGNING IN

To sign in, driver must input an already registered email and password.

If driver has no account, the driver should contact their Carrier Administrator to create an account for them.

If the Truck ID and Vehicle VIN isn't already prefilled, then user has to enter these values.

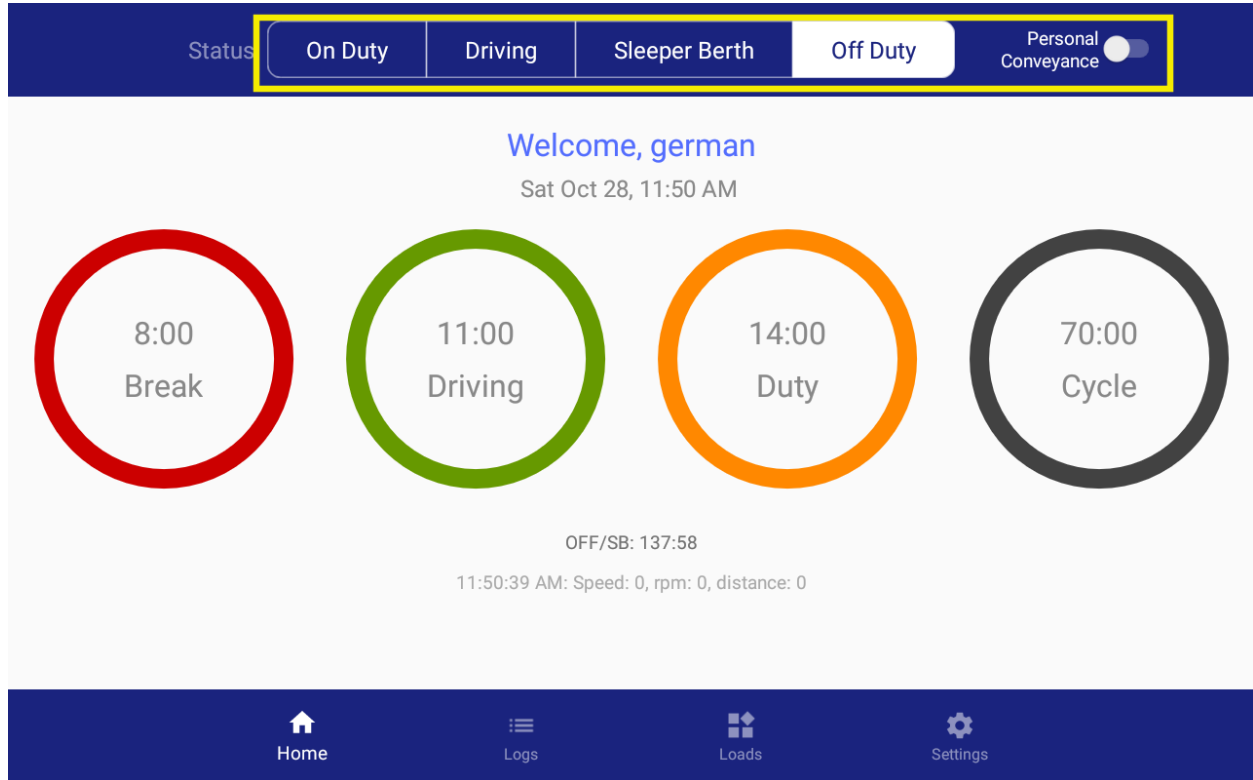

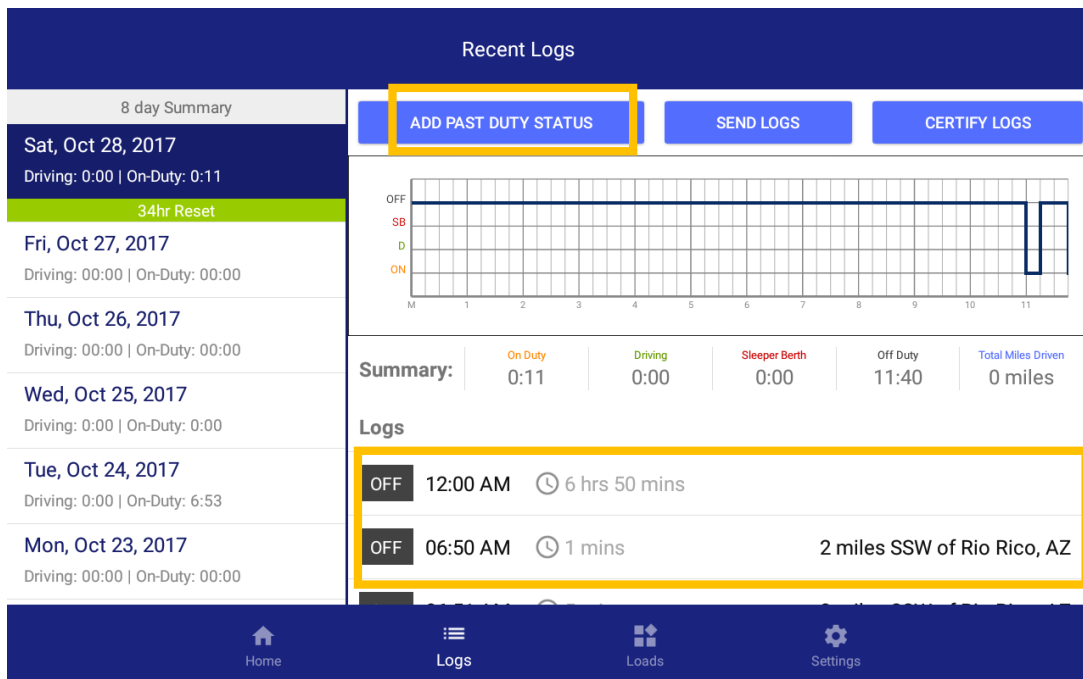

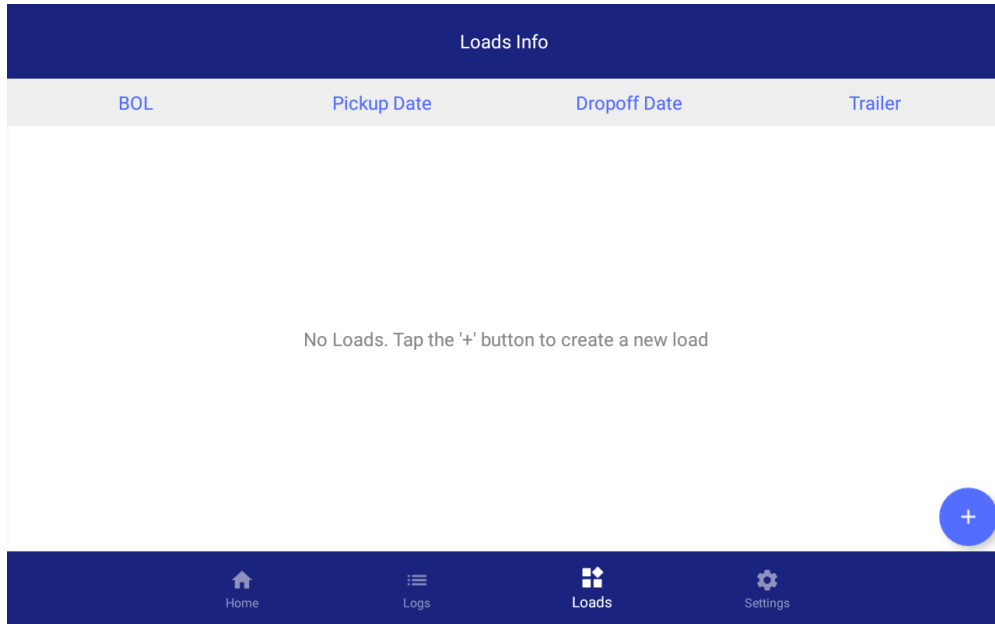

LOADS TAB

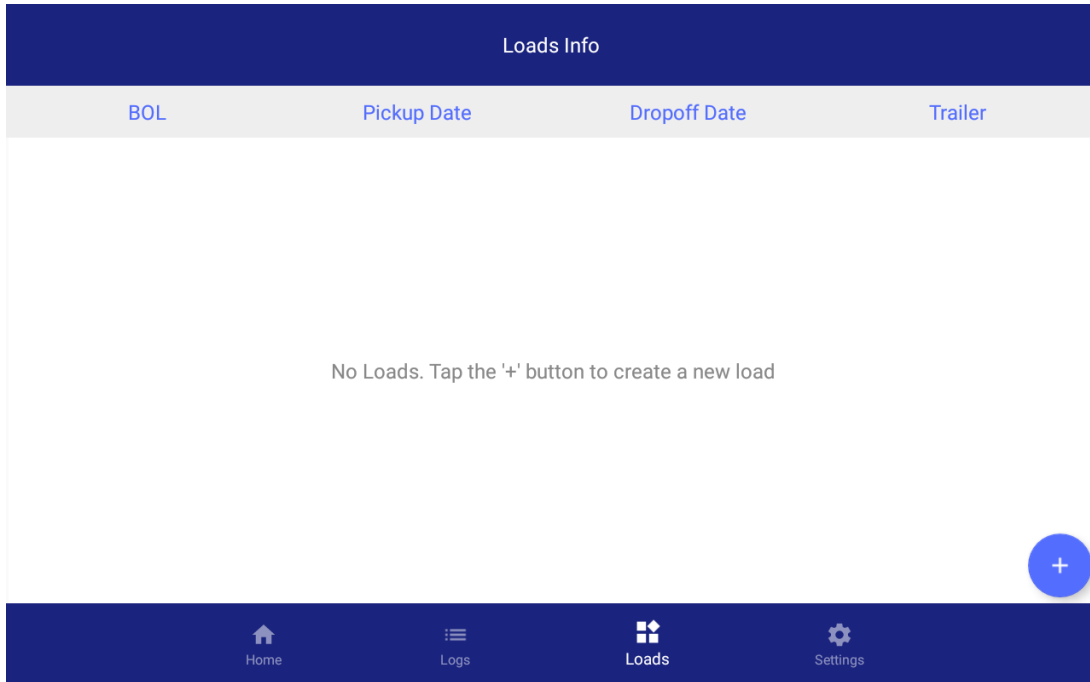


The load tab serves as a record keeper of loads the current driver has hauled.

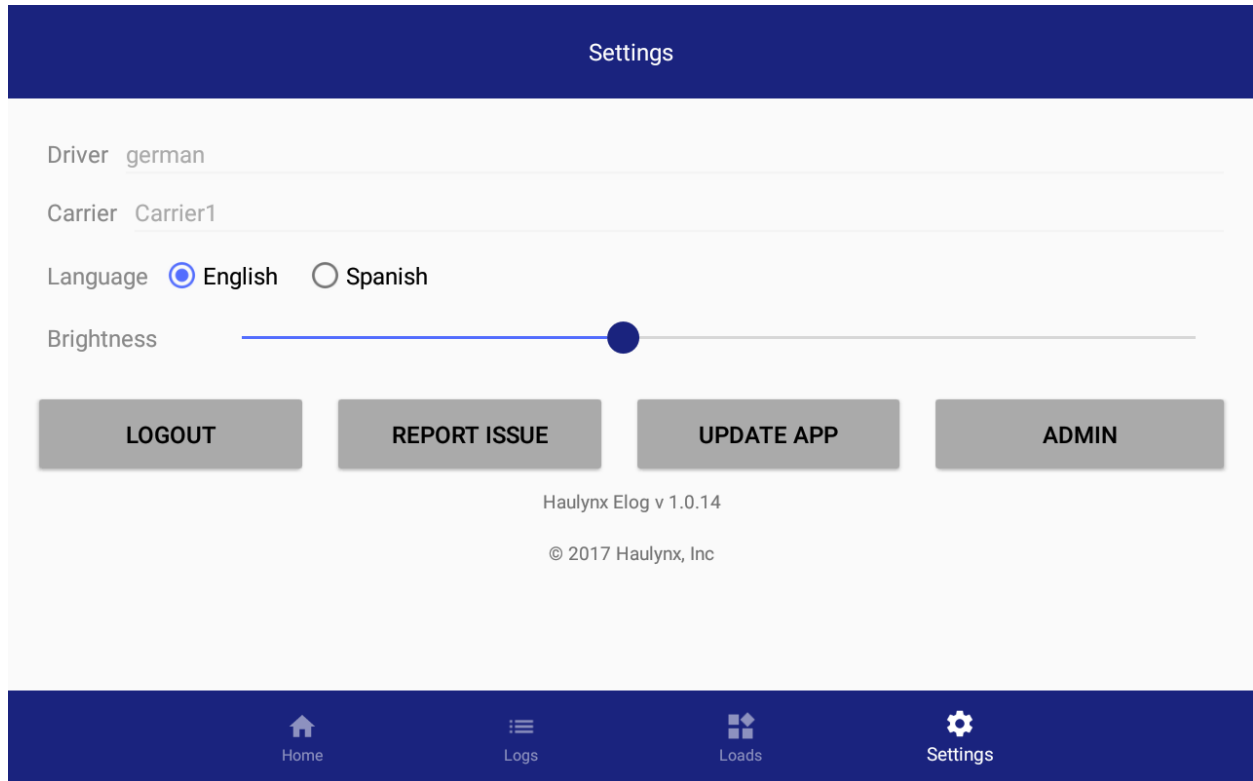
