







5. Tap on **Login** button






This section offers quick access to important features within the application. Users can access the application preferences to customize their experience, view the user manual to learn more about the application and its features, or log out from the application with just one tap.








Assignments





DVIR

Online Reports

The DVIR feature provides a way for you to create online "Driver's Vehicle Inspection" reports while in the field. This helps to ensure that your vehicle confirms to the FMCS's safety regulations.

Defects

Having vehicle and trailer numbers populated automatically, the driver just needs to select the defects from the long list of pre-determined values.

Condition & Remark

Driver can choose a condition of the vehicle ("Satisfactory", "Unsatisfactory") from the dropdown list and may add comments or remarks against a DVIR in the input field just below it.


Inspection

Visual Inspection

Review logs for the current 24-hour period and the previous **seven** consecutive days tap "**Start Review**" button and give your device to the DOT Officer.

Information Packet

View user manual and instructions.



Transfer Logs

Transfer data of the compilation of the driver's ELD records.


Email Printout

Email logs for the current 24-hour period and the previous **seven** consecutive days Email your logs to the DOT Officer if they request a paper copy of your logs.

Inspection


